

International Initiatives on Collaborative Learning: Teacher Education Reform through Lesson Study

The Fukui Roundtable is held bi-annually in February and June. The Roundtable consists of five zones (A, B, C, D, E). Zone D International provides a platform for collaborative learning on practices and future prospects for teacher education reform inside and outside Japan.

Since 2021, as part of its global development, the University of Fukui has been focusing on the Nalikule College of Education and its demonstration school in the Republic of Malawi and following the process of their reflective lesson study. In June 2021, Nalikule College of Education shared their initiatives and collaborative learning through lesson study in their own context in Zone D. We realized how crucial it is to work on it from a long-term perspective through practice and reflection. Therefore, we continuously follow the progress of their reflective lesson study practice.

This Zone will consist of two sessions; symposium and “Roundtable”. In the symposium, the symposiast will discuss the approaches, results, and challenges of lesson study at Nalikule College of Education and its demonstration school. In the “Roundtable”, educators from other countries will share their lesson study practice and learn from each other in small group discussions. We hope that the various examples will stimulate you to reflect upon your own practices. These sessions will be conducted in English and translated to Japanese.

Zone D では、実践における協働的な学びのプラットフォームを提供し、国内外の教員養成の展望を拓くことを目的としています。2021 年からは、福井大学が行っているマラウイ共和国のナリクレ教員養成大学及び附属高校との協働と連携して実施しています。今回も引き続き、現地の授業研究のアプローチや成果、課題について報告してもらい、世界各国の教育関係者と実践や学びを共有し、捉え直しを行います。この Zone での事例紹介と議論を通して、参加者自身の実践と省察が深まることを期待しています。
